	Inpatient Discharge Days: Differences in patient population and breadth of services provided explains differences in the comparison of patient days. For example: EKL Cardiac patients were transferred to other hospitals if interventional procedures were needed, reducing patient days. OLOL offers full-service cardiac care which increases patient days.
